All Together Now: Enhancing the Healthcare Experience This course will review how ED staff, the Transfer Center, and Inpatient staff will work together to enhance the healthcare experience for patients who are admitted from the ED to the Inpatient floors. The new process will decrease our patients' wait time in the ED for an inpatient bed. By working together as a Healthcare team the strain and stress of admissions will be reduced. This course is based on the standard work resulting from the throughput project. In addition, CNAs will demonstrate how to obtain orthostatic vitals, as well as identify when to notify the nurse of an abnormal result. Staff will com- plete a brief online module and then complete a demonstration at EXPO.
