# East Campus Classroom Locations

## Basement Classrooms

Take elevators or stairs by coffee shop to Basement floor. When you get off elevators (or out of stair well) take a left. All classrooms will be down this hallway. This is the same level if you park in the east parking lot and enter through the dock doors

<b>Grand Teton</b>	At the end of the hallway on the left
<b>Warren</b>	Half way down hall to the right (there are two doors to this classroom)

## 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Classrooms

When you come in the main entrance go past the check-in desk. Continue until the hallway comes to a "T" on the tile floor. Take a right. Go through the door that is on the left side of the elevators. Turn Left (except for the MPR room—see below)

<b>East MPR (Multi-Purpose Room)</b>	Continue straight ahead through the lobby area and through the door. The MPR is the large room on the right hand side of the hallway.
<b>White Buffalo Computer Lab</b>	This is 1st room on the left side of the hallway
<b>Wrangler</b>	This is the 1st classroom on the right side of the hallway
<b>Crow Creek Crossing</b>	This is the 2nd room on the left side of the hallway
<b>Gannett Peak</b>	This is the last classroom on the right side of the hallway
<b>Capital</b>	Go to the end of the hallway, take a right and this room will be the <u>first</u> room on the left
<b>Meadowlark</b>	This is the 2nd classroom on the right side of the hallways (between Wrangler and Gannett Peak)
<b>Legion Park</b>	Go to the end of the hallway, take a right and this room will be the <u>second</u> room on the left

## 4<sup>th</sup> Floor

Use elevators by coffee shop, take to the 4th floor, you will take a right turn off the elevator then take a left down the hallway.

<b>Western Wheatgrass</b>	This room is about half way down the hall on the left side
<b>Simulation Room</b>	This room is about half way down the hall on the right side
<b>Cottonwood</b>	When you get off the elevators turn right and go straight into the room with the windows
<b>RQI</b>	When you get off the elevators, turn right, then take a right turn. Turn left at the next hallway. Go through the double doors (usually propped open), turn right before the next set of elevators.

## Respiratory Protection & N95 Mask Fit Testing

This course is designed to provide a competency assessment on the use of the CAPR devices and fulfills the annual requirements for N95 mask fit testing.

- *All staff are required to attend regardless of when you completed your last mask fit testing/training (even those completed in December)*
- *Agency at Managers Discretion*
- *Facial hair must be shaved prior to attendance for staff wishing to wear an N95*
- *You should not eat, drink, or smoke 30 minutes prior to attending the course. (This could cause you to not pass your fit testing)*
- *If you are attending Expo for other courses we ask that you enroll for this during expo as well.*
- *If you do not wear a PAPR/CAPR frequently, we encourage you to attend the live training that will be available at this time.*
- *You must complete the online learning before you can sign-up for a class.*
- *If you need to attend expo for other events, please attempt to complete your N95 Mask Fit Testing and Respiratory Education at the East Campus to allow others that do not need to come to Expo to complete theirs at the West Campus.*
- *All staff that were hired in 2023 or prior will need to complete a mask fit testing.*

**\*\*\* Please Note:** Staff that are not medically cleared for N95 through Occupational Health will not be eligible to fit test on the same day and may require medical clearance through your PCP.

# In-Person Class Offerings

**ARU CARF: Dysphagia & Transfers in Stroke and Spinal Cord Injuries**

Participants will engage in activities to identify food and liquid textures available at ARU. They will identify symptoms of dysphagia that warrant referral to SLP. Additionally, we will review transfers, log rolling, and lift utilization with patients who have a SCI.

**Approximate time to complete: 50 Minutes**

**Required for:**

**Optional for:**

- Any Clinical Staff Member

**Basic EKG**

This course will review normal cardiac anatomy, physiology, and electrical conduction through the heart. Participants will learn to identify and relate waveforms to the cardiac cycle; will review and utilize a systematic process when interpreting rhythm strips; and discuss characteristics of abnormal rhythms.

*This class is offered once a month, several months each year. This offering falls on an expo day. For mor questions about this class please contact Colleen Rodgers or Jessica Buchholz.*

**Approximate time to complete: 4 Hours**

**Required for:**

- Nurse Residents: This class is required for Nurse Residents during their Residency Year. If you have not yet taken this class, this Expo offering is an opportunity for you take it.

**Cheyenne Regional Trauma Lecture Series: Trauma in Pregnancy**

This course will provide an overview of key principles of the assessment, interventions, and evaluation of the pregnant trauma patient.

**Code Yellow and Restraint Chair**

Code Yellows and use of the restraint chair are deemed to be a high risk event. Therefore, it is critical that staff routinely review and practice how to intervene when the situation arises. Attendees will review the Code Yellow Process, how to use the Restraint Chair, and CPI holds.

## Cybersecurity/Phishing Training:

This training is required for staff that have failed to recognize a phishing email one or multiple times over the past year.

**Deep Dive into Phishing:** Understand the sneaky tactics used by cybercriminals. We'll explore what phishing is, why it's dangerous, and the common tricks used, like emotional manipulation and deceptive web addresses.

**Real-World Examples:** Analyze actual phishing attempts and learn how to dissect their anatomy. Can you spot the red flags in a seemingly legitimate email?

**Hands-On Strategies:** Learn critical skills like web address analysis and the dos and don'ts of handling suspicious emails.

**Interactive Scenarios:** Test your new skills with interactive examples. It's time to apply your knowledge in real-time!

**Emergency Response:** What should you do if you or a colleague gets phished? Learn the immediate steps to minimize damage.

## USP 800 Hazardous Drugs

**Annual Healthstream Modules**

We heard your concerns about getting so many annual modules with limited time to complete them every May. We will be rolling out most of your annual modules (Regulatory and Clinical) in January and you will have until June 30th to complete them. Some modules will have a delayed roll-out and you may see additional modules added to your Healthstream between January and April. Having your modules starting in January will allow you to complete on days you are low censused or as time permits. ***Some of the required checklists will be available now; however, we will provide an opportunity for you to complete your required checklists at the May Expo.***

**Improved Psychiatric Documentation in the Emergency Room**

This education will help employees working in the Emergency Room Psychiatric Care areas understand documentation requirements and implement new processes for documentation while caring for psychiatric patients. The course will detail upcoming changes to EPIC flowsheets associated with caring for psychiatric patients in the Emergency Room.

**New Masimo Tetherless Pulse Oximetry**

It focuses on the causes and consequences of nicotine use.
