

How MyChart Bedside Supports You and Your Baby in the Hospital



Stay Connected to Your Care



Be more involved with your birth experience while you're at Cheyenne Regional Medical Center Women and Children's Services. Download the MyChart app before admission and tap "View Hospital Stay" to be logged in automatically when you arrive.

Stay In Touch With Your Care Team



See the names and photos of the doctors, nurses, and specialists who are caring for you and your baby. Send secure messages and request comfort items right from the app.

See Your Baby's Information Right Away



Access your newborn's chart as soon as they're born. Review vital signs, medications, and health updates – all in one place.

View and Sign Care Forms



Read and sign important care forms for yourself or your baby directly in MyChart Bedside – no paper or delays.

Track Care for You and Your Baby



Stay on top of your hospital schedule. View upcoming medications, procedures, or imaging for both you and your baby. Keep a **feeding log** and **diaper log** to help your care team track progress.

Stay Informed With Results



Receive your lab and test results for both you and your baby as soon as they're available.
